Sav-A-Life Calhoun County is a crisis pregnancy and family resource center. They now have two offices; Anniston and Jacksonville. They have been in the Anniston area for over 20 years and have been blessed to open their second facility near the JSU campus in 2011.

SAL is a non-profit Christian ministry that is solely run on donations sent from local individuals, businesses, and churches. Their mission is to save

lives and offer spiritual and emotional help to women affected by unplanned pregnancy. They encourage women to "choose life."

SAL offers free pregnancy testing, Christian mentoring, ultrasounds, post-abortion counseling, STD, abstinence information, and the new Earn While You Learn Program. EWYL is an incentive based, mentoring

program that offers classes to ladies in our community. One can choose from over 80 classes covering topics such as pregnancy issues, parenting tips, life skills, budgeting, and an excellent Bible study. Participants earn Mommy

Money and Daddy Bucks that can then be spent in our Baby Boutique.

Sav-a-Life became a part of the Chamber two years ago in hopes of 'spreading the word' about their ministry. They believe "our new EWYL program is improving families, therefore improving our community. We were pleased to find
