Youth Leadership Calhoun County (YLCC) is a program of the Calhoun County Chamber of Commerce. This 9 month program provides the class members with the tools to develop individual leadership skills, increase their understanding of our community and be part of leadership outside the classroom. Class members network with other young leaders in the community from different schools with different backgrounds and establishes friendships that will last into their future.

Selection Process

- Deadline for submitting the application package: **February 26, 2020**
- Interviews scheduled for: **March 2-5, 2020**
- Top 32 application/interview scores determine the future 11th graders chosen to represent their schools for the program.

Most session dates are on Tuesday with the exception of the Parent/Student Orientation in September, possibly the October session, and the February session.
