What is Leadership Calhoun County?

Leadership Calhoun County (LCC) is a program of the Calhoun County Area Chamber & Visitors Center. It is designed to prepare and build upon leadership resources within our entire county. Each class will be comprised of leaders and emerging leaders in the county.

Selection Process

- Deadline for submitting the fully completed application package: **October 14, 2022**
 - Nominees should be individuals who have strong leadership qualities and who would contribute to the class and benefit from LCC.
 - The Selection Subcommittee shall review all applications (which include a headshot, letter of recommendation, and \$25 application fee), interview the candidates and submit nominations to the LCC Advisory Committee. The committee shall attempt to represent a broad spectrum of firms and organizations throughout Calhoun County.
 - A 15 minute formal panel interview of applicants by the Selection Subcommittee will be held on: **Thursday, November 2, 2022 all candidates are asked to hold this date.**
 - Selection Subcommittee will score applicants based on application and an interview.
 - No individual, business, or organization is guaranteed a representative(s) in the LCC Program.
 - Each nominee must be an employee of an active member of the Calhoun County Area Chamber & Visitors Center.
 - A maximum of two (2) applicants by a company or organization.
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Tuition (Due upon acceptance into the class)

All nominees will be asked to complete the application form and return it to the Calhoun County Area Chamber & Visitors Center. Applications will have a \$25.00 non-refundable application fee. If accepted into the LCC program, **tuition of \$800.00 will be due by January 5, 2023.** The tuition covers all costs of the Team Building/Orientation and ten (10) class sessions over the ten (10) month program including food, bus transportation for State Government Day, and materials. Tuition is non-refundable, in whole or in part, in the event one fails to complete the program due to attendance or other reasons.

Attendance

A class member may miss up to one and a half (1½) days and still be eligible for graduation from the LCC Program. Beyond the one and a half (1½) days, the class member must make up one of the missed days by the following LCC class cycle. No more than two (2) days total can be missed.

Alumni Dues

Each year, graduates of the Leadership Calhoun County program give back by paying dues (\$50) to fund Youth Leadership Calhoun County (YLCC). These dues pay for students from throughout Calhoun County to receive the same benefits, friendships, and knowledge each LCC class member receives through the Chamber's leadership programming. The dues also support future leaders by funding two \$2,000 scholarships to graduates of the YLCC program who will be attending an in-state accredited college or university. LCC graduates are personally responsible for these dues, as many of their employers do not cover this fee.
